### SGHS NCEA Evidence Exams/CAAs/Cambridge Evidence Exams

NCEA Evidence exams will run from Wednesday 11 September until Wednesday 18 September

- Morning Examinations begin at 9:00 am and can be 1 – 3 hours long.
- Afternoon Examinations begin at 1:00 pm and can be 1 – 3 hours long. Students will need to be available until 4:00 pm.

Students in Years 11, 12 and 13 will have study leave at this time, and only be required at school for their timetabled exams. The exam timetable will be published in the next Friday Flyer.

Employers' responsibilities under the Education and Training Act 2020 state that students are not required to work in times that interfere with the student doing schoolwork.

Attendance at these exams is compulsory for all students enrolled in the course

- For some Level 1 subjects they contribute towards a student's final grades
- They provide important evidence about student's achievement of assessment criteria, helping students and teachers to develop feed forward for next learning steps as well as evidence if a derived grade is required due to unforeseen circumstances in the NCEA examinations at the end of the year.
