Vaping

As a follow up to article in the last Friday flyer on vaping, we want to share some disturbing facts about vaping.

- The standard vape pod (2ml) at 2% strength or 20mg has the same amount of nicotine as a 20 pack of cigarettes. Many teenagers are vaping these 2ml vapes at least once day.
- Nicotine in vapes is very addictive. Nicotine is active in the body for around 30 minutes before withdrawal symptoms start again.
- The withdrawal from nicotine can make people feel irritable, restless, unable to concentrate, and most people experience cravings when they go without it.
