PERSONAL LEARNING CONFERENCES (PLCs) - Monday 17 March 2025

We invite you to the Personal Learning Conferences (PLCs) for 2025 being held on Monday, 17 March from 9.00 am until 6.00 pm. <u>Please note</u> there will not be any classes on this day, so you will need to make alternative arrangements for your child. It is an expectation that all students attend with their parents. However, senior students Years 11-13, must attend on their own if parents can't attend.

We continue to offer 2 alternative ways to attend the PLCs:

- Video Conference
- Face to Face at SGHS (this is the preference)

Depending on the option you choose for your child's PLC we ask;

- That you and your child are together for either type of conference, on the same device in the same location/room.
- If using the video conference option all you need is an internet connection, a web browser (e.g., Chrome), and a device with a camera and microphone (e.g., smart phone, iPad).
- Students are expected to be present at their PLC, whether it be face to face or video conference.
- Students are not expected to wear uniform to their PLC.

At the Personal Learning Conference, you will work with your child's AT/Homeroom teacher to develop / refine their goals and to formulate their next learning steps.

If you have a child who is doing one or more Cambridge subjects and you would like to find out more about the course(s) and the IGCSE Cambridge Examinations, there will be an opportunity to attend an information session which will be held in the library on Monday 17th March. The first session will be at 12.00pm to 12.30pm and it will be repeated at 5.00pm to 5.30pm. To prepare for this Conference your child has spent time with their subject teachers reflecting on their learning, next steps, and Learning Habits.

Personal Learning Conferences are a partnership between the student, whānau and the school:

For students, the Conferences are an opportunity to:

- Develop and extend their ability to talk about learning.
- Deepen their relationship with their parents/caregivers around their school learning, to celebrate what
 has been learnt.
- Shape their ability to clarify what they are learning and assess their own progress.
- Reflect on their learning and modify it as a result of the reflection.

For whānau, the Conferences are an opportunity to:

- Actively and meaningfully support your child in their learning.
- Understand more fully what they are learning and the progress they are making.
- Support your child with their goals.
- Enjoy a rich, learning-orientated conversation with your child and their teacher.
- Be aware of how much your child is taking responsibility for their own learning.

Some suggestions to think about...

- What do you and your child feel that they do well and why?
- What do you and your child feel that they need to improve and why?
- What does your child enjoy doing when they are not at school?
